Upstate Forever and partners have scheduled a public meeting to discuss the “Three and Twenty River Watershed Based Plan,” a grant funded project targeting bacteria, sediment, and nutrient pollution in the Three and Twenty Watershed rivers. This watershed based plan provides a comprehensive overview of the sources of bacteria and sediment pollution in these watersheds and identifies critical areas for restoration and protection. The plan will also provide strategies to reduce or eliminate pollution loads within watersheds.
